Founded by French colonists in 1718 and becoming part of the U.S. through the Louisiana Purchase in 1803, the city thrives on tourism, trade, and energy. Nicknamed NOLA or the Big Easy, it boasts a unique arts scene and distinctive architecture. Due to its low-lying geography, New Orleans relies on extensive drainage systems to manage stormwater and support its development.

Local Sports

New Orleans is home to a variety of professional and semi-professional sports teams, each with a rich history and passionate fan base. Whether it's the electric atmosphere of the Superdome on game day or the local pride in smaller teams, New Orleans' sports scene is deeply woven into the fabric of the city.

LSU Tigers Football (NCAA)

The LSU Tigers football program represents Louisiana State University and competes in the NCAA's Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) and the SEC's Western Division. The team has won four national championships and produced three Heisman Trophy winners, including Billy Cannon, Joe Burrow, and Jayden Daniels. LSU plays at Tiger Stadium in Baton Rouge, and Brian Kelly is the current head coach.

New Orleans Gold (MLR)

New Orleans Gold is a professional rugby team competing in Major League Rugby (MLR). As one of the founding teams of the league, they have helped popularize rugby in the region. The team has a growing fan base and contributes to the diversity of the sports culture in New Orleans.

New Orleans Jesters (NPSL)

The New Orleans Jesters are a semi-professional soccer team playing in the National Premier Soccer League (NPSL). The team has been a key part of the local soccer scene, offering opportunities for local talent to compete at a high level and fostering a growing soccer community in the city.

New Orleans Pelicans (NBA)

New Orleans Saints (NFL)

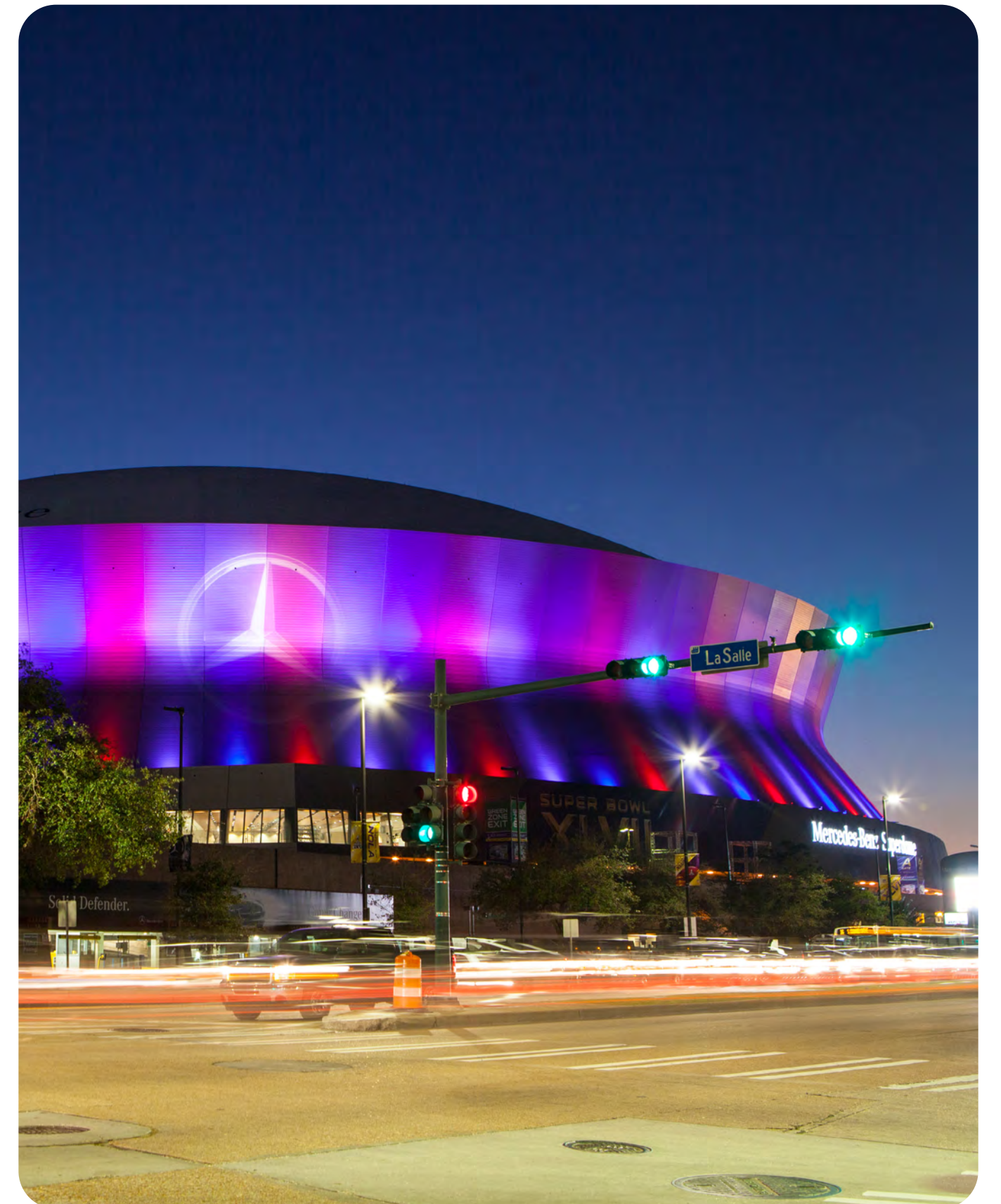

Golf Courses

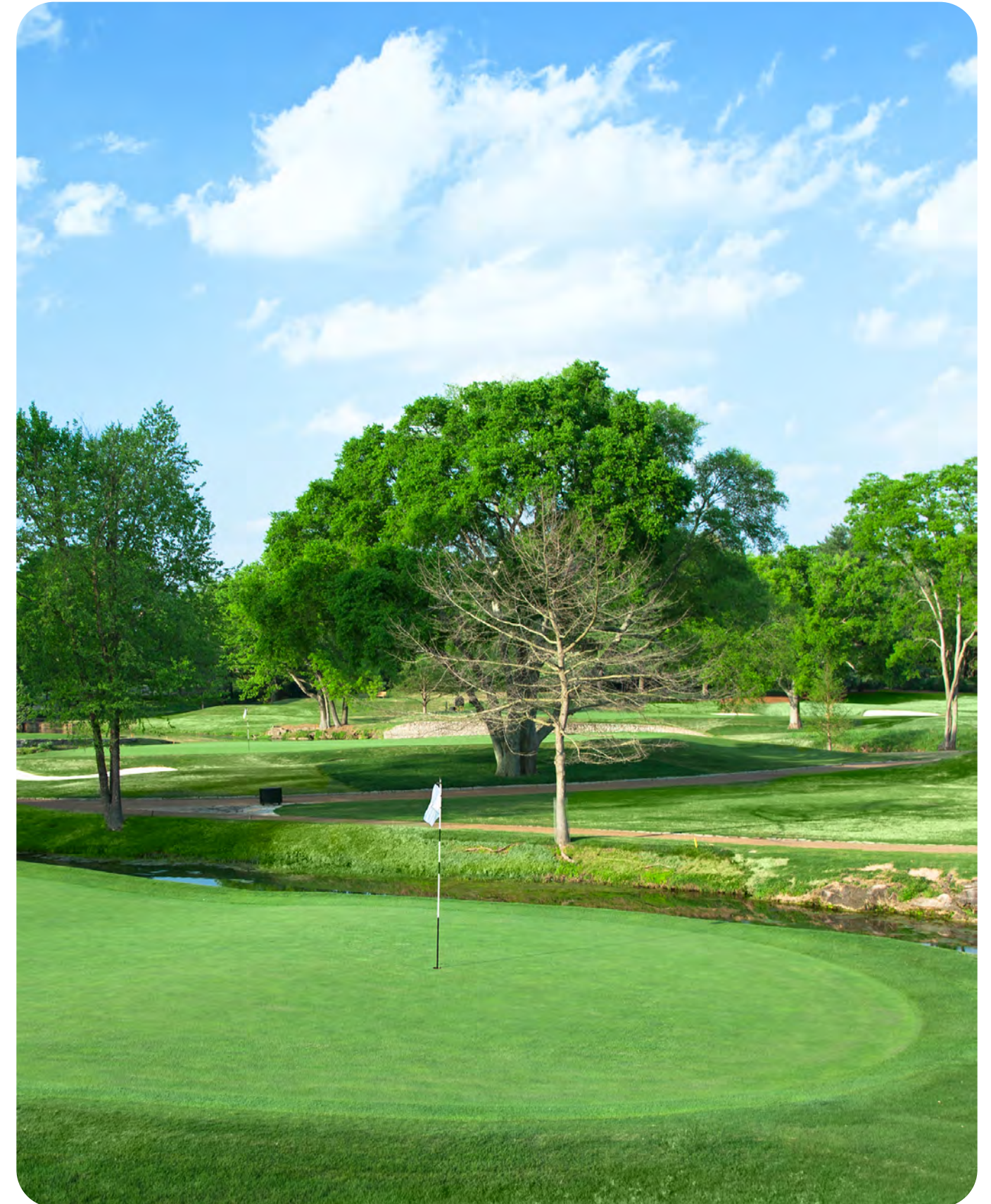
